

Taylor Wildlife new recruit COVID-19 procedures

Seasonal roles with Taylor Wildlife are likely to involve living in shared accommodation as part of a close-knit survey team. For this reason, we have developed protocols and procedures to ensure that the risk to staff and local residents is minimised.

New staff may be asked to self-isolate where possible in the period leading up to their employment with Taylor Wildlife. Staff will be asked to take a COVID-19 swab test in the 3-4 days prior to joining their team. Tests will be provided by Taylor Wildlife and will be received and sent via post. You will be required to share the test results with senior staff. It is important that you self-isolate in between taking the test and joining the survey team.

For the duration of the survey season, team members should have limited contact with other households. This may mean no mixing indoors with other households, even when government guidelines permit this.

We endeavour to keep survey teams working on separate sites as much as possible. When this is unavoidable, any mixing of survey teams must be limited and our protocol on the use of face coverings, hand sanitiser and physical distancing must be followed. Our COVID-19 policy, protocol documents and risk assessment will be included in the welcome pack for successful candidates. Staff are encouraged to receive the vaccine if and when they become eligible.

If you believe you are at high risk of complications from COVID-19, you may need to consider whether this position is appropriate for you at this time.
